What does it mean to Dwell? How does this title relate to my work in general?

My presentation covers the thinking of Heidiger, Tim Ingold and the likes, referring to dwelling with ultimately a link to migration, territory and location (bi-location).

In his essay “Bauen Wohnen Denken” translated to English: Build, Live, Think; the philosopher Martin Heidegger’s approach to landscape as dwelling inspired the title to my work.

Landscape and Dwelling are inseparable ideas. To foster a better understanding of Dwelling, Ingold distinguishes between landscape and task scape. He defines a task as “any practical operation, carried out by a skilled agent in an environment...”
